

★Do you know "Young Carers" ?★



Although there is no legal definition, it is generally defined as "children under the age of 18 who routinely perform household chores and family care that adults are supposed to be responsible for."

Carrying excessive burdens that are not appropriate for your age may affect your academic performance, career path, and friendships. Also, some children feel that their situation is taken for granted and cannot send out an SOS.



Doing household chores such as shopping, cooking, cleaning, and doing laundry on behalf of a family member with a disability or illness



Taking care of younger siblings on behalf of family



Taking care of or watching over a sibling with a disability or illness



Always caring for the family by keeping an eye on them, watching over them, and speaking to them.



Interpreting for families where Japanese is not their first language or families with disabilities



Working to support the household and helping family members with disabilities or illness



Dealing with families with alcohol, drug and gambling problems



Caring for family members with chronic illnesses such as cancer, incurable diseases, and mental illnesses



Taking care of a family member with a disability or illness



Assisting family members with disabilities or illnesses in bathing and going to the toilet.
