Agreement	<p>I and the student involved in the application agree to the following matters when applying for the subsidy for school lunch expenses for elementary and junior high school students in Anjo City (hereinafter referred to as "subsidy").</p> <p>①To the extent necessary for the mayor to determine whether subsidies can be granted or not, the Basic Resident Registers of myself and the students involved in the application must be viewed.</p> <p>②To the extent necessary for the mayor to determine whether or not subsidies are to be paid and the amount to be paid, the head of the school where the child/student pertaining to the application is enrolled will be informed of whether or not they are receiving special support education enrollment incentives, and other subsidies. To inquire about payment categories of incentive fees, school lunch expenses related to special needs education enrollment incentive fees, and other information necessary for granting subsidies.</p> <p>③The principal of the school must make the mayor an answer to the inquiry in ② above.</p> <p>④In the event of violation of the Anjo City Regulations Concerning Budget Execution of Subsidies, etc. and the Anjo City Elementary and Junior High School School Lunch Fee Free Project Implementation Guidelines, the subsidies received pursuant to the provisions of the same regulations shall be returned.</p>
