- ④In the event of violation of the Anjo City Regulations Concerning Budget Execution of Subsidies, etc. and the Anjo City Elementary and Junior High School School Lunch Fee Free Project Implementation Guidelines, the subsidies received pursuant to the provisions of the same regulations shall be returned.
